DAY 1: Strength

Be strong in the Lord and the power of His Might
Ephesians 6:10

Pray that God will strengthen you and the church body to accomplish His will in our generation.

DAY 2: Boldness

.....Pray also for me so that when I begin to speak, the right words will come to me. Then I will boldly make known the secret of the gospel.

Ephesians 6:19

Pray for boldness to spread the message of hope found in Christ and that your words would be encouraging and uplifting to the hearer.

DAY 3: Fear

*So you have not received a spirit that makes you **fearful** slaves. Instead you received God’s Spirit when HE adopted you as His own children. Now we call Him Abba Father.(Daddy) Romans 8:5*

Pray for a heart free of fear and anxiety. Pray to receive the fullness of His love and to reveal what this adoption truly means.

DAY 4: Bitterness

Get rid of all bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, and slander, as well as all types of evil behavior. Instead, be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you. Ephesians 4:31-32

Pray for God to reveal any bitterness in your heart and to remove the root and restore joy and peace.

DAY 5: Forgiveness

When you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything against anyone, so that your Father who is in Heaven will also forgive your trespasses. Mark 11:26

Pray for God to reveal any unforgiveness in your heart and to restore those relationships.

DAY 6: Missionaries

Go ye therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Matthew 28:19

Pray for all dedicated to local & foreign missions. Ask the Lord to reveal 'your' role in the harvest.

DAY 7: Praise

Praise Him for His acts of power; praise him for his surpassing greatness. Praise Him for His mighty works; Praise Him for His unequaled greatness!!!

Psalm 105:2

Be still and know that I am God... Psalm 46:10

Praise Him and sing and dance before His throne of grace. Be grateful for all of His blessings.

DAY 8: Trust

Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take.

Proverbs 3:5,6

Pray for a growing confidence and dependence on God that is marked by having the courage to follow and obey him in three key areas of your life: time, talents, and resources.

DAY 9: Authority

Everyone must submit to governing authorities. For all authority comes from God, and those in positions of authority have been placed there by God. So anyone who rebels against authority is rebelling against what God has instituted, and they will be punished. Romans 13:1,2

Pray for a greater understanding of seeing what God is teaching you through those He put in authority in your life.

DAY 10: Faith

Be on guard. Stand firm in the faith. Be courageous. Be strong. 1 Corinthians 16:13

Pray that your life will be marked by a great confidence in God, especially when circumstances don't make sense.

DAY 11: Return to your first Love

This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun! 2 Corinthians 5:17

Pray that your life would be free from the pursuits of this world (pleasure, money, success, and fame) and that you would learn how to seek God and his kingdom first.

DAY 12: Love your neighbors as yourself

Do not seek revenge or bear a grudge against anyone among your people, but love your neighbor as yourself. Leviticus 19:18

Pray for God to give you a burden to see those you interact with come to know Christ and His love.

DAY 13: Church leaders

Have confidence in your leaders and submit to their authority, because they keep watch over you as those who must give an account. Do this so that their work will be a joy, not a burden, for that would be of no benefit to you. Hebrews 13:17

Pray for those God has placed in our lives as spiritual leaders.

DAY 14: Thankfulness

.....Rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught and overflowing with thankfulness. Colossians 2:7

Pray for a rooting & grounding of faith in Christ Jesus and His word to create a steadfastness and thankfulness for all His goodness towards us; so we can minister love to others

DAY 15: Wisdom

Do not forsake her and she will guard you; Love her and she will watch over you. The beginning of wisdom is; Acquire wisdom; and with all your acquiring, get understanding. Prov 4:6,7

Pray for wisdom in knowing how to regularly apply the Scriptures you're reading and the talks you're listening to. Ask God to give you wisdom in spiritual conversations with others.

DAY 16: Discipline

To learn, you must love discipline; it is stupid to hate correction. Proverbs 12:1

Pray for a humble and teachable spirit that allows you to be receptive to what God is trying to teach you. Also ask the Holy Spirit to grow you in the area of discipline.

DAY 17: Word and Power

For the word of God is alive and powerful. It is sharper than the sharpest two-edged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. It exposes our innermost thoughts and desires. Hebrews 4:12

Pray that God's Word (Scripture) would reveal the hidden parts of your life, so that you can deal with them in a healthy way.

DAY 18: Patience

Understand this, my dear brothers and sisters: You must all be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to get angry. James 1:19

Pray for the patience to truly **listen** to others and to respond as the Spirit directs.

DAY 19: Unity

Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love. Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace. Ephesians 4:2,3

Pray that God would help you recognize the importance of prioritizing His plans over your desires and personal preferences.

DAY 20: The persecuted Church

"But I say to you, love your enemies, and pray for those who persecute you." Matt 5:44

Pray for those persecuting Christians that they would see the love of God and repent. Also pray for strength & grace for the persecuted.

DAY 21: Adoration

All the earth bows down to you; they sing praise to you. It will make music to you. It will make music to your name. Selah. Let all the earth adore thee, and sing to thee: let it sing a psalm to thee. Psalm 66:4

Adoration is an intense admiration in reverence and worship with the outward acts and attitudes, which accompany such reverence.

Spend time on your knees adoring our Savior.

DAY 22: Those with little

Pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their trouble, and to keep oneself unspotted from the world. James 1:27

Pray the people being ministered to at our outreach center. Also pray for those faithfully reaching out to the less fortunate in the greater Pulaski area.

DAY 23: Mercy

Be merciful as your Father is merciful.

Luke 6:36

Pray that God would extend His hand of mercy on our communities as idolatry increases. Ask the Lord to give you the ability to show mercy to others as He did for you.

DAY 24: Burn off the Dross

But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!

Galatians 5:22-23

Pray that God will bring you through whatever process is necessary to produce godly fruit in your life.

DAY 25: Generosity

The generous will prosper; those who refresh others will themselves be refreshed.

Proverbs 11:25

Pray for God to stretch your faith and dependence on Him in the area of generosity.

DAY 26: Spiritual Gifts

Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophecy. 1 Cor 14:1

Pray for the Holy Spirit to give you a hunger to demonstrate the reality of the kingdom of God today. Ask Him to speak through you to others.

DAY 27: Understanding

Make your ear attentive to wisdom, Incline your heart to understanding; For if you cry for discernment, Lift your voice for understanding.

Proverbs 2:2,3

Pray for the Holy Spirit's divine intervention to understand wisdom as you study the word of God.

Day 28: Worship

God is spirit and his worshipers must worship in the spirit and in truth.

John 4:24

Spend time praying in the Spirit. Take time to listen for God speaking to you.

DAY 29: Examine my heart

Put me on trial Lord and cross examine me and my heart.

Psalm 26:2

Pray for God to search your heart and examine your motives and any insecurities.

DAY 30: Blessings

"I will not let You go unless You bless me!"

Genesis 32:26

Ask God to give you an ongoing passionate desire to spend time in His presence daily.
